

**Minutes of meeting of BCCI appointed Sub-Committee held at JKCA office Jammu**  
**on 19 June 2021\***

**1. Audit**

It was decided to get audited complete accounts of JKCA from the year 2003 till up-to-date.

The audit report will be submitted to BCCI for further action as deemed fit.

**2. Following information to be sought from Affiliated Clubs latest by 15 July 2021:**

The clubs to be asked to submit the following information to J&KCA latest by 15 July.

- a) Constitution.
- b) Terms of the club's year wise from 2003 onwards
- c) Details of participation of club teams (men & women) in various cricket tournaments from 2003 onwards
- d) Details of elections held on yearly basis. The list of elected office bearers.
- e) Details of the offices of the clubs to include location, mailing address, email id. To also include details of assets, fixtures and facilities.
- f) Details of players belonging to the club who represented J&K in various tournaments.
- g) Details of funds received from JKCA.
- h) Details of club members who have incurred disability under Lodha panel report.
- i) Details of any financial help received by any club member in any capacity from JKCA.

**3. Following information to be sought from District Associations latest by 15 July 2021:**

- a) Constitution including the registration certificate of the Association.
- b) Funds received from JKCA since inception.
- c) Expenditure report of funds.
- d) Details of office to include location, mailing address, email id also to include details of fixtures, assets and facilities.
- e) Details of any financial help received by the association members from JKCA in any capacity.



4. In order to rationalise and staff of JKCA to prepare service regulations. Also streamline service conditions of the employees of JKCA. Recruitment rules for employees of JKCA to also be framed.
5. Dispose-off two vehicles of 2003 vintage which are parked and lying-in unserviceable condition. The vehicles were damaged during the floods in Kashmir.
6. In view of the prevailing security environment in the UT, it was decided to carry out a thorough review of security at Jammu and Srinagar offices. It was also decided to approach J&K administration for provision of security to sub-committee members
