MINUTES OF THE VIDEO CONFERENCE HELD ON 24 JUNE 2021

1. A video conference meeting of Members, Sub-Committee was held on 24 June 2021. The conference was attended by Brig Anil Gupta (retd.), Member-Administration via online from JKCA Jammu office, Mr. Sunil Sethi, Member Legal via online & Mr. Mithun Manhas, Member-Cricket via online from Delhi.
2. The main agenda of the meeting was "Engagement of standing Counsels" both at Jammu & Srinagar. The salient points of the meeting are as follows:
 - a. Mr. Sunil Sethi, Member-Legal explained the need for appointing standing counsels for JKCA. He proposed that one senior advocate each be appointed at Jammu & Srinagar and two juniors advocates each at Jammu & Srinagar.
 - b. After a brief discussion a consensus was arrived to appoint only one senior Advocate based at Jammu as the senior standing counsel on per hearing basis. It was also mentioned that per hearing fee of a senior advocate is Rupees Seventy-Five Thousand to one lakh per hearing, Mr. Sethi Proposed the names Sh. U. K. Jalali, Ex Advocate General, Sh. K. S. Johal for Jammu, Sh. Riaz Jan and Sh. Altaf Naik, Senior Advocates for Srinagar.
 - c. Brig Anil Gupta, Member Administration proposed the name of Sh. Rahul Pant. After a brief discussion Mr. Mithun Manhas, Member Cricket was also inclined towards Sh. Rahul Pant. It was finally decided to refer the matter to Sh. Jay Shah, Secretary, BCCI for final decision. Mr. Mithun Manhas was requested to interact with BCCI.
 - d. It was thereafter discussed to appoint two junior advocates each at Jammu & Srinagar. It was mentioned by Member-Administration that since there are no court cases presently, it may not be needed to appoint these advocates on monthly retainership for the time being. However, the other members felt that there was a necessity for the same. It was again decided to seek approval of the BCCI.
