## Minutes of the Sub Committee meeting held at Srinagar on 29<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> October, 2021

The following were present.

- Brigadier Anil Gupta - Member Administration
- Sh. Sunil Sethi - Member Legal
- Sh. Mithun Manhas – Member Cricket ( Through Video Conference from Jammu)

- The following important decisions were taken:
  - Diwali bonus at the rate of Rs. 1000 per employee to be paid to all the employees of JKCA.
  - The request received from employee's to review earlier decision to give free tea twice a day instead of Rs. 600 tea allowance was discussed. Employees have now requested revert back to the earlier system. It was decided to discontinue free tea and in lieu give Rs. 500 per month per employee as tea and snacks allowance.
  - Mr. Sunil Sethi, Member Legal, carried out a thorough review of various files of legal cases by earlier Advocate Mr. Qadri. Mr. Sunil Sethi recommended that though only one file pertaining to pending case was of Aisha Construction was relevant but all files must be kept safely handed over for record purposes.
- Accounts for month of September were perused and approved by all members.
- Secretary Amar Singh Club Srinagar had approached JKCA Office Srinagar for construction of a boundary wall (which was washed away during 2014 floods) separating the club premises and the Sher-e-Kashmir Stadium. The Sub Committee members visited on spot along with Secretary Amar Singh Club and Mr. Majid Dhar, Incharge Cricket Operations & Development Kashmir. It was decided to obtain rates for construction of a chain link fence and the cement block wall. Also it was decided that the iron scrap lying at the side which was also washed away during the flood should auctioned. It was decided that the cost will be bound both by the Club and JKCA.
- A meeting was held with President District cricket Association Kulgam- Mohammad Iqbal Ganai. The views of Mohammad Iqbal Ganai were taken on the issue of dispute between club and the district Association as well as a resume of the activities done by the district association was given by the President.
