MINUTES OF MEETING OF SUB COMMITTEE JKCA HELD AT JAMMU ON 06TH MARCH, 2022

The following were present:

- a. Brig. Anil Gupta (Retd.) – Member Administration
- b. Mr. Sunil Sethi – Member Legal Affairs
- c. Mr. Mithun Manhas – Member Cricket Operations & Development

1. The Minutes of Meeting held at Srinagar on 06th September 2021 were read and approved by all members.
2. The state of CCR's as on 31 December 2021 and statement of accounts as on 28th February were perused and signed by all members.
3. The Member Administration briefed the other members about the Ranji Match between Karnataka and J&K played at IIT Chemplast ground Chennai from 24th February, 2022 to 27th February 2022 which he had attended as observer along with Mr. Ashwani Gupta, Member Cricket Advisory Committee. The performance of few players which had bearing on the result of the match was highlighted by Member Administration. A detailed discussion thereafter was held about the performance of the team in that match and the ongoing match between Railways and J&K. Mr. Mithun Manhas, Member Cricket Operations & Development was authorised by the Sub Committee to obtain feedback from the Management Committee and thereafter decide the action that may be taken to enhance the performance of Senior Team in future.
4. Member Administration also briefed the Sub Committee about the launching of JKCA Website (www.jkca.tv) and social media pages on facebook and twitter. Mr. Sunil Sethi, Member Legal Affairs advised that the website should be made fully secure and the issue regarding the slowness should be resolved at the earliest.
5. The following decisions were taken:
 - a. To further increase the duration of payment of incentive money at the rate of 3000 per month to the staff of JKCA as approved during the meeting held on 30th September, 2021 till 30th April, 2022 or later depending upon the revised schedule of BCCI for the season.
 - b. To go ahead with the purchase of Electric Load Carrier from Piaggio Commercial Vehicles by incurring additional expenditure of Rs. 81,054 as societies are not authorised for subsidy as per the existing Government Orders.

- c. In view of the forthcoming summer season and frequent power cuts in Jammu, sanction was accorded by the Sub Committee to purchase a 25 kg automatic start backup generator for JKCA Complex Office at Jammu.
- d. Approach Government (UT) for allotment of fresh piece of land for construction of a cricketing facility at Jammu instead of the land already allotted at Majalta which is not suitable for the purpose.

6. Discussion on the Writ Petition filed by a few District Associations

The Writ Petition has been filed in the J&K High Court by few District Associations against BCCI and JKCA. The contents of the Writ Petition were discussed. It was thereafter decided to authorise Mr. Sunil Sethi, Member Legal Affairs, to supervise and guide the Legal Team of JKCA and brief the Sub Committee periodically of the progress on the subject.

7. Domestic Calendar for 2022

The Sub Committee was of the view that to promote cricket and hunt talent, JKCA should divide the entire area of responsibility into zones and appoint Zonal Organising Committees constituting preferably of former players who should also be called as Talent Hunt Committees. These Committees should be made responsible for conducting Zonal Tournaments leading to UT level tournaments in the following formats:

- a. Upto 19- One Day Tournament for Men and Women: Each Team must include minimum 3 players from the age group below 16.
- b. Senior Women- One Day
- c. Senior Men (above 19): One Day, Two Day (90 over a side) & Three Day format.

Mr. Mithun Manhas, Member Cricket Operations & Development, was entrusted the responsibility of going into further details and prepare the calendar for the schedule and method of conduct of the various tournaments. The members were of the view that each region be divided in four zones.

e.g. : 1. **Kashmir Region** into North, Central, South Kashmir, Ladakh (including Kargil)

2. **Jammu Region** into

- a. **Zone One comprising-** Ramban, Doda, Kishtwar
- b. **Zone Two comprising -** Udampur, Reasi, Kathua
- c. **Zone Three comprising -** Jammu, Samba
- d. **Zone Four comprising -** Rajouri, Poonch

The final decision was vested in Mr. Mithun Manhas & CAC.

8. Hiring and Preparation of new Grounds and Pitches

Three grounds have been identified at Jammu and three grounds at Kashmir for development of pitch and preparation of grounds. Further negotiation to be undertaken by



the Sub Committee with the owners of the ground. In addition it was also decided to approach JKPA at Udhampur for providing land for development of a proper cricket ground at Udhampur. For grounds at other districts in both Jammu & Kashmir, Sports Council will have to be approached. It was also decided to approach Jammu University and sign a MOU with them for use of the newly prepared Turf wicket and Cricket Ground by the University.

9. Budget for Cricketing Infrastructure and Conduct of Domestic Tournaments

Mr. Mithun Manhas, Member Cricket Operations & Development, requested additional time of 4 to 5 days to finalise the same. Mr. Sunil Sethi, Member Legal Affairs, proposed that completion of abandoned work at Sher-i-Kashmir stadium, Srinagar which is the only JKCA stadium in the UT should also be included in the infrastructure budget.

10. Development of Office Infrastructure:

There is acute shortage of Office and storage spaces in the present JKCA Complex which has been built on adhoc basis adjacent to the Hostel Ground, GGM Science College Jammu. The following additional infrastructure is needed to ensure smooth functioning of JKCA from Jammu:

- a. 2 into dressing rooms with Urinal and WCs
- b. One into Gymnasium with Changing and toilets
- c. One open shed for shortage of machinery
- d. One into Office Room (for staff)
- e. One into Office Room (for Member Legal Affairs/ Ombudsman)
- f. One into record room
- g. Two into store rooms
- h. One into room for Officials during matches
- i. One into toilet Ladies, One into toilet for gents
- j. One into car parking

The Sub-Committee after deliberation agreed to the proposal and decided to go in for pre-fab shelters.

11. Case Pertaining to Mr. Ahsan Ahmed Mirza

It was decided to file an application with Hon'ble Court to release the amount due to JKCA from the seized properties of Mr. Ahsan Ahmed Mirza as was reported recently in the newspapers. Mr. Sunil Sethi was requested to follow the case.

12. Service Rule and Regulation of JKCA Staff

Mr. Sunil Sethi, Member Legal Affairs, was authorised by the Sub Committee to formulate the same.

13. Monetary Assistance to Mr. Shibhan Lal Trakroo

Mr. Shibhan Lal Trakroo, Former Ranji Trophy Player, has requested financial help for Medical Treatment as he has been diagnosed with Malignancy. The Sub Committee

considered the case and decided to help the former cricketer as was approved in the previous meeting held on 6th & 7th January, 2022 that medical assistance in case of extreme need could be given. It thus agreed to provide medical assistance of Rs. 90,000 in favour of Mr. Shibani Lal Trakroo as a good will gesture to the former Ranji Player of the state.

14. Retirement of JKCA Staff over 60 years Age

During the Sub Committee meeting held on 28-08-2021, it was decided to retire those JKCA employees who have completed 60 years of age. The following names have been received from Srinagar and Jammu Office:






