MINUTES OF SUB-COMMITTEE MEETING HELD AT JAMMU ON 22nd OCTOBER, 2022

1. The Sub-Committee took the review of the preparation for the upcoming matches to be hosted by JKCA both at Jammu & Srinagar. The Sub-Committee was satisfied with the preparation so far but observed with concern the slow pace of completion of newly laid wickets. The Sub-Committee directed the Curator Mr. Vivek Sharma to ensure that the wickets are ready in all respects as on 30th October, 2022 as promised earlier by him.

2. The following decisions were taken:

- It was decided to construct 02 Pre-fabricated dressing rooms in order to ensure security and safety of Players and Officials by separating the entry for spectators and Players. The process for construction of the dressing room has already been set in motion by issuing advertisement in the newspapers. Since the first match is scheduled to be held on 12th November, 2022, the Sub-Committee agreed to the suggestion of Member Administration that the dressing room should be ready as soon as possible but not later than 05th November, 2022.
- The Sub-Committee ratified its earlier decision to enhance the Festival Bonus of Rs. 2000 per employee for the season 2022-23.
- In view of the only ground available at Jammu, the preparation camps to be held for the preparation of our National teams, need careful planning, hiring of suitable grounds from other sources will be needed. Member Administration briefed the Committee that Jammu University has hiked the ground rent to Rs. 20,000 per day while the owner of Gharota Ground is demanding Rs. 12,000 per day. Similarly, KC Sports is also demanding between Rs. 12,000 to Rs. 15,000 per day. On the advice of Senior Men Selectors, Mr. Mohit Puri was sent to see the facilities at 17 Miles. As per

his report, the facilities are good and meet our requirements. Apart from practice, it has full fledged turf wicket ground. The owner has agreed to rent the ground at Rs. 5,000 per day. The Sub-Committee agreed approval for hiring of 17 Miles ground. Mr. Sethi, Member Legal volunteered to check again with the owner of KC Sports Club.

- d. The Schedule prepared for various camps was perused by the Sub-Committee and approved.
 - e. In view of the upcoming National Matches, the services of Mr. Vivek Sharma, Curator is recommended to be extended till 31st March, 2022 subject to his satisfactory performance.
 - f. The Sub-Committee authorized Member Administration to appoint various Committees for conduct of National Matches at Jammu & Srinagar.
3. The draft constitution was also discussed and suggestions given by the Members were agreed to be included.
- 4. Interaction with Clubs:**
Four Clubs of Jammu having inter club dispute have been invited for interaction on 22nd October and 23rd October. Both parties have been invited for the interaction. It was decided to call remainder clubs and District Associations after Diwali.
- 5. Complaint against J&K Bank:**
It has been pointed out by the Auditors for the FY 2021-22 that an amount of approximately 1.77 crore has been wrongly deducted by the bank from the interest of our FD. The bank was approached to rectify the mistake but no positive response was received. Therefore, it has been decided to refer the matter to the Ombudsman and also lodge FIR against the bank.
