## MINUTES OF SUB-COMMITTEE MEETING HELD AT JAMMU ON 03<sup>rd</sup> DECEMBER, 2022

The following points were discussed:

### 1. Review of the performance of JKCA Teams:

The Sub-Committee expressed satisfaction at the performance of the JKCA team in Vinoo Mankad, Vijay Hazare and U-25 Men's State A Tournaments. It is for the first time in the history of JKCA that all three team qualified for the knockout. However, the Sub-Committee Members were not satisfied with U-19 Men's team performance in Cooch Behar Trophy and has decided to focus more on multi day format in the coming season. The proposed talent hunt tournament for the year 2023 was also discussed and also the possibility of starting the J&K League in One Day/Multi Day format was also proposed. However, it was decided to defer the finalization of the same till mid February when the current season will be over. It was also decided that the Senior Women's Team be sent to Puducherry atleast one week in advance of the scheduled date of tournament in order to acclimatize and have match practice at the venue.

### 2. Felicitation of the Teams:

The Sub-Committee decided to felicitate the teams that have entered the knockout stage during this season and the Senior Women's team which also created a record by entering the quarter final during the last season. After a lot of deliberation it was decided that the members of the Senior Teams and the Support Staff will be paid an award money of Rs. 2 lakh per head. Whereas the members of other teams and Support Staff will be paid an award money of Rs. 1 lakh each. It was decided that the players with outstanding performance will be rewarded in addition of the award money by presenting good quality Cricket bats/ other cricketing equipments. The issue of presenting a memento to all was also discussed. It was agreed that a Kashmir Willow bat with names of the players and Support Staff engraved on

### 3. Development of Cricket Grounds in and around Jammu:

The following grounds have been identified:

- Cricket Ground at Sher-I-Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences & Technology, RS Pura (Jammu)
- Bhagwati Nagar, Jammu
- Khel Gaon, Nagrota
- Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University, Katra

Mr. Sunil Sethi, Member Legal was authorized to approach Divisonal Commissioner for allotment of land at Bhagwati Nagar, Jammu.

### 4. Reappointment of Ombudsman:

The Sub-Committee approved the re-appointment of Justice Narsimha Rao Reddy as Ombudsman of JKCA for the period of six months subject to further extension w.e.f. 01<sup>st</sup> December, 2022.

### 5. Reappointment of GST and Tax Consultant:

The Sub-Committee approved the re-appointment of Mr. Vasu Gupta, CA and Tax Consultant of JKCA w.e.f. 01<sup>st</sup> September, 2022 to 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2023 subject to further extension.

### 6. Review of Staff Strength at Srinagar Office:

It was pointed out by the Member Administration that the strength of Staff at Srinagar Office viz a viz workload is excessive since the major load now is being shared by the Jammu Office from where the headquarters also functions. After a lot of deliberation, it was decided that Mr. Majid Dar, Incharge Cricket Developing Activities, Srinagar will carry out a thorough review of the workload of various staff members employed at Srinagar office and recommend to the Sub-Committee the names of those who can either be transferred to Jammu office or declared surplus to establishment.

### 7. Purchase of Curtain Nets for the Practice Pitches at Jammu:

Mr. Mithun Manhas, Member Cricket Operations & Development, JKCA, discussed with the Sub-Committee, JKCA about the necessity of providing modern infrastructure at JKCA Cricket Ground, Jammu where the practice pitches have been newly laid. He recommended
