## MINUTES OF THE SUB-COMMITTEE MEETING HELD AT JAMMU ON 08<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER, 2023

1. The Sub-Committee Members perused the monthly account statements and account books for the month of August, 2023 and approved the same. Also the balance sheet and Statutory annual Audit report of JKCA for FY 2022-23 was checked and passed by the Sub-Committee Members. It was decided to send the report to the BCCI.

2. The schedule of National matches to be played at Jammu was discussed and approved by the Sub-Committee Members. Brig. Anil Gupta, Member Administration JKCA, also briefed about the visit of Mr. Abey Kuruvilla, Manager Operations, BCCI, to Jammu for checking the newly introduced venue at University Ground, Jammu. The observations made by Mr. Abey Kuruvilla were discussed and it was resolved to rectify at the earliest in collaboration with the team of Jammu University.

3. **Additional Assets required for National Matches:**

Since simultaneous matches will be held at Jammu, there is a need for additional assets required for smooth conduct of these matches. The list of proposed additional assets was placed before the Sub-Committee by the Member Administration. After a thorough discussion, the requirement of procurement of additional sets was agreed to. The list of approved additional assets is attached. It was also decided to shift 6 Ghora (Video Camera stand) from Srinagar to Jammu. The necessary instructions for the same have been issued to Mr. Majid Dar, Incharge Cricket Developing Activities, Kashmir.

4. **Insurance of Assets at JKCA Complex:**

Member Administration, JKCA highlighted the necessity to insure the assets at Jammu in view of its location very close to the river Tawi and other natural/manmade hazards. The suggestion was approved by the Members and it was also decided that similar insurance should be done for the JKCA assets at Srinagar.

5. **Letter from Ex-Ombudsman JKCA:**

It was decided to request him once again to send a fresh invoice duly signed and also clarify to him that no other dues are pending to be paid to him. Action has been completed.

6. **Issue of Practice Schedule at JKCA ground Jammu & Srinagar:**

The members appreciated the excellent practice facilities prepared both at Jammu and Srinagar and were of the view that the players must be encouraged to make the use of same for practice so that they can continue to hone their skills. Member Cricket Operations & Development, JKCA agreed to issue a schedule for the same.

7. **Schedule of Preparatory camps 2023-2024:**

The schedule was discussed threadbare. Member Administration also informed that the teams from Chandigarh, Punjab and Himachal Pradesh have agreed to visit Jammu and Srinagar for practice matches against U-19 Men's, Sr. Men's, U-19 Women's and Sr. Women's. This may necessitate few modifications in the existing schedule once the dates are confirmed by the Guest Associations.

8. **Participation of JKCA teams in Outstation tournaments:**

An approval was given for U-23 Men's team participation in JP Attray Memorial Tournament and U-16 Boy's team in Shri Balramji Das Tandon Memorial Tournament both to be held at Chandigarh.

9. **Update on disposal of fallen trees:**

Refer to Para 11 of Minutes of Sub-Committee Meeting held on 08<sup>th</sup> August, 2023. Member Administration, JKCA informed that fallen trees have been sold to M/s Ali Timber Fire work Contractor for Rs. 17,600. M/s Ali Timber Fire work Contractor was the highest among the five bidders.

10. **BCCI Annual General Meeting 2023:**

The Sub-Committee agreed unanimously to nominate Member Administration, Brig. Anil Gupta (Retd.) to represent JKCA for the AGM 2023.

## **11. Uniform for Practice Matches:**

## **12. Establishment of Pro and Coffee shops at Jammu & Srinagar:**

Mr. Mithun Manhas, Member Cricket Operations & Development, JKCA suggested that Pro shops for the benefit of players should be opened both at Jammu and Srinagar. Mr. Sunil Sethi, Member Legal was of the view that we must also establish coffee shops both at Jammu and Srinagar wherein the players can interact informally and make use of the proposed library. The suggestions were agreed to. Member Cricket Operations & Development, JKCA was authorised to finalise the modalities of Pro shop and Mr. Sethi was requested to suggest suitable cafe owners for establishment of coffee shops.

## **13. Procurement of LED Score board:**

It was also decided to procure a LED Score board for the Hostel Ground, Jammu.
