1. The Sub-Committee perused the accounts for the month of July, 2023 and approved the same.

**2. Ratification of Appointments for the Season 2023-24:**

The Sub-Committee approved the appointment of Cricket Advisory Committee (CAC) and Senior Selection Committee (Men), Junior Selection Committee (Women), Senior Selection Committee (Women) & Junior Selection Committee (Men).

**3. Clothing for the Season 2023-24:**

The Sub-Committee approved the recommendations of the board constituted for Tender Opening of the Uniforms to purchase the clothing from SG Industries for the season 2023-24.

**4. Inclusion of Professional Player in Senior Men's Team:**

Member Cricket Operations & Development, JKCA, Mr. Mithun Manhas proposed that there is a need of hiring a professional player for the Senior Men's Ranji Team to ensure proper balance in the team. He stated that the Professional to be selected should also be capable of captaining the team. A few names were discussed including Mr. Faiz Faizal, Mr. Paras Dogra, and Mr. Wrridhiman Saha. Mr. Sunil Sethi suggested that we should hire a young player so that he can also participate in other formats. He proposed the name of Mr. Shikhar Dhawan. After a lot of deliberations, the names of Mr. Paras Dogra and Mr. Shikhar Dhawan were shortlisted. Member Cricket Operations & Development, JKCA, Mr. Mithun Manhas was authorised to further negotiate with the players.

## 5. Purchase of Specialised Equipments for Senior Teams:

Mr. Chirag Pandya, Physiotherapist, Sr. Men's Team has recommended purchase of Match Ready Ice Machines at the scale of one each for Senior and U-23 Men's Teams. Member Cricket Operations & Development, JKCA, Mr. Mithun Manhas explained about the utility of the said machine to the other members. It was unanimously agreed to purchase 02 machines at the earliest.

## 6. Construction of Sliding Sight Screen at Srinagar:

Member Cricket Operations & Development, JKCA, Mr. Mithun Manhas stated that there is a need to have sliding Sight Screen for the newly laid practice wickets at JKCA Cricket Stadium, Srinagar. The proposal of Member Cricket Operations & Development, JKCA, Mr. Mithun Manhas was agreed to by the other members.

## 7. Pulley system for curtain nets at Jammu & Srinagar:

Member Cricket Operations & Development, JKCA, Mr. Mithun Manhas suggested that to ensure the longevity of newly installed curtain nets at both Jammu & Srinagar grounds, there is a need to attach pulley system for drawing and closing curtains. The Sub-Committee agreed to suggestion of Member Cricket Operations & Development. It was decided to procure drawings, designs and quotations from M/s SG Industries, Meerut.

## 8. Discussion on MOU received from Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board:

JKCA has approached Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board for using their stadium at Katra for development into a cricket stadium for use of women players. Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board has agreed to the proposal and thereafter shared a MOU for our acceptance. The Sub-Committee Members examined the contents of the MOU and were of the view that there is a need for further deliberations with Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board. Mr. Sunil Sethi suggested that Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University Katra can be contacted for providing their ground which can be developed into an exclusive Cricket ground. Since it also has the added benefit of making hostel accommodation of University for accommodating players. Mr. Sunil Sethi was authorised by the Sub-Committee Members to negotiate the matter with Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University.

**9. Enhancement of Storage space at Hostel Ground, Jammu:**

Member Administration, JKCA, brought out that there is acute shortage of storage space at Hostel Ground, Jammu because of which our stores and clothing are getting damaged. The Association has procured training stores, physiotherapy stores, clothing and machinery which needs proper storage space. The Sub-Committee decided to extend the existing storage shed as interim measure as well as to construct a new storage shed (pre-fab) at Hostel Ground, Jammu.

**10. JKCA Tie and Blazer:**

The Sub-Committee agreed to procure ties and blazers for the Sub-Committee Members, CAC Members and the captains of various teams. It was also decided to procure ties as a souvenir of the Association.

**11. Disposal of Fallen Trees:**

A permission from the Forest Department has been obtained for removal of six eucalyptus and one Banyan tree at Hostel Ground, Jammu. The Sub-Committee members authorised Member Administration, JKCA to dispose off the same.

**12. Representations Received from Mir Manzoor Ganzafar (Sangam Cricket Club) and Sheikh Abdul Rauf (City Cricket Club):**

Member Administration briefed the members regarding letters with affidavit received from the persons mentioned above. In their letters, they have stated that their signatures have been forged and misused by the Petitioners in SLP No. 19979/2023 listed before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The letters and the affidavits were perused minutely by the members. After deliberations, the following decisions were taken:

- To wait and watch if some more individuals whose names also appear in the said document approach the Association.
- To refer the matter in the form of a complaint to Crime Branch, Srinagar to make a thorough investigation and take action against the offenders.
