1. Draft Constitution:

The Sub Committee members perused the final draft of the amended constitution of JKCA in line with the Lodha panel recommendations and gave approval for the same to be submitted to the Committee JKCA.

2. Review of the National Level matches being conducted by JKCA:

The members expressed satisfaction at the arrangements made at the Hostel Ground and the Jammu University Ground. The performance of the JKCA teams was also discussed.

3. Meeting with Parvez Rasool:

Mr. Mithun Manhas briefed the members about the meeting with Parvez Rasool, a cricketer of JKCA. He mentioned that Parvez has shown willingness to play for JKCA. The members were briefed by Brig Anil Gupta (Retd) as to why he was not considered by the Selection Committee for this season. He had failed to attend the camp held in June for selection of probables for the seniors teams across the formats for this season. He did not inform any reason to the Association and instead preferred to play club cricket in Sri Lanka. Mr. Sunil Sethi felt that in view of his performance he may be considered if agreed upon by the Senior Selection Committee. It was unanimously decided to refer the matter to the Senior Selection Committee.

4. Construction of concrete stair case leading to the office:

Brig Anil Gupta (Retd) informed the members that the existing wrought iron staircase has become shaky and unsafe. It may lead to an accident. He proposed to construct concrete stair case instead. Mr. Sunil Sethi was of the view that a lift should be installed. After deliberations it was decided to go in for the concrete stair case urgently to prevent any accident taking place. The proposal of lift be also kept in mind and be considered later.
